

DBE PROGRAM UPDATE

Construction Phase
DBE Participation
(as of March 31, 2025)

Construction of the [Purple Line Transit Project](#) (Project) is well underway. The Project has a 22% DBE goal for Construction. [Maryland Transit Solutions](#) (MTS) continues to make progress toward Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation on the Project. The bar graph below indicates the number of DBE subcontractors, and the number of DBE awarded subcontracts currently on the Project.

PURPLE LINE PROGRESS UPDATE


Baltimore Avenue - Rossborough Lane
Beginning on or about March 17, 2025



(Route 1) at the intersection of Rossborough Lane. Traffic on Baltimore Avenue (Route 1) will be reduced to one lane in each direction from Fraternity Row to Hotel Drive through spring 2025. Additionally, Rossborough Lane will remain closed at Baltimore Avenue (Route 1). Access to Yale Avenue will be maintained via a detour from Hotel Drive to Diamondback Drive. The crosswalk at Baltimore Avenue (Route 1) and Rossborough Lane will be closed, pedestrians should follow onsite signage and cross at the open signalized crosswalks at Fraternity Row or Hotel Drive.

Pedestrian detours are clearly marked. If a full closure is required, a detour route will be provided while flaggers may be utilized for partial closures.

Access will always be maintained to businesses and residences and notifications to the public are provided before closures occur via design-build contractor Maryland Transit Solutions' construction alerts.
