
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## DBE PROGRAM UPDATE

Construction of the [Purple Line Transit Project](#) (Project) is well underway. The Project has a 22% DBE goal for Construction. [Maryland Transit Solutions](#) (MTS) continues to make progress toward Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation on the Project. 
### Temporary Closure of the Wayne Avenue and Fenton Street Intersection

*Through September 05, 2025*



The temporary closure of the Wayne Avenue and Fenton Street intersection has been **extended to about September 5, 2025**, due to unforeseen utility conflicts. Crews are doing everything they

Through approximately September 5, 2025, crews will install light rail tracks, reconstruct sidewalks, and complete stormwater drainage and utility crossings across the intersection of Wayne Avenue and Fenton Street. This work has required a temporary full closure of the Wayne Avenue and Fenton Street intersection to vehicular traffic. WMATA and Ride-On bus routes may be affected. Please check directly with your transit service provider for any updates or detour information. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Please follow posted signage and directions from on-site personnel



Please note that weather and unforeseen conditions may impact work schedule.

## Purple Line Testing Advisory - Nighttime Activity Beginning August 2025

*Beginning July 28th, 2025*


Beginning on or about July 28, 2025, Purple Line crews will begin testing the light rail tracks and systems between Annapolis Road and the New Carrollton Station.

(LRVs) will begin to occur nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. During this time, LRVs will periodically travel along the tracks and through intersections, supported by police or traffic control personnel.

Temporary traffic holds of up to 15 minutes will occur at the following intersections

- Annapolis Road and Veterans Parkway
- Veterans Parkway and Ellin Road•
- Ellin Road and Hanson Oaks Drive•
- Driveways along Ellin Road

Additionally, Emerson Place at Ellin Road will be closed nightly throughout the LRV testing period. Emergency vehicle access will always be maintained, and pedestrian crossings will be actively managed, though brief delays may occur while LRVs pass.
