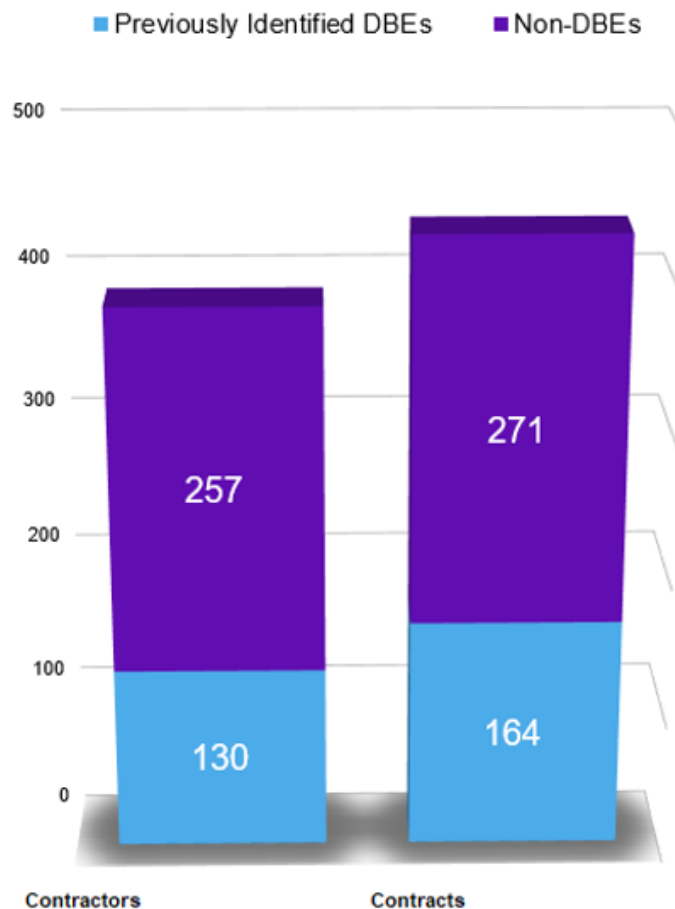

Construction of the [Purple Line Transit Project](#) (Project) is well underway. The Project's 22% DBE goal for Construction has been modified in accordance with the [Interim Final Rule \(IFR\)](#) released by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) on **October 3rd 2025**. Following this review, [Maryland Transit Solutions](#) (MTS) continues to make progress toward Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation on the Project. The bar graph below indicates the number of SBE subcontractors, and the number of SBE awarded subcontracts currently on the Project.

Note: Some contractors hold multiple contracts on the Project.



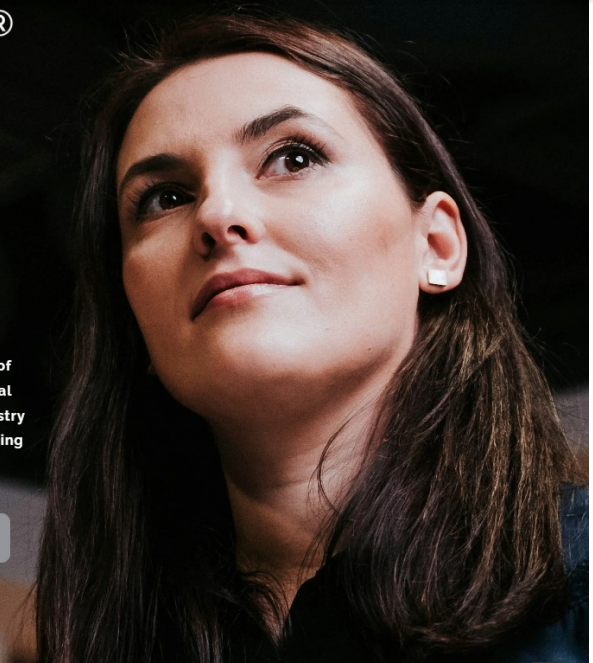
